REBUILDING THE ORGAN AT WESTLETON

KEY CHANGE ‘PLANT A PIPE’ SCHEME

Westleton has most of the pipework and much of the wood needed to build the refurbished organ. However, a lot of work of building the instrument and also cleaning and repair of many of the older pipes still has to be paid for. In order to defray the costs of the work, Key Change is asking for donations to help plant pipes in each part of the instrument as a series of four “Plant a Pipe” schemes – one for each department of the organ. **To plant a single pipe can cost as much as £116 or as little as £1.50**, depending on the size of the pipe and which rank of pipes in the organ it belongs to.

Series Two: ‘Plant a Pipe in the Swell Organ’ aims to attract donations for planting pipes in one of the major departments of the organ. This series will run until December 31st 2008.

When you donate to the series you will be awarded a certificate that will record which pipes will be planted with your help.

Donations in excess of £50 will also be acknowledged by a framed copy of the certificate.
